Ashore – inland, ring **0705 818888**, state that you are dealing with a diving emergency.

If you are calling in business hours, ask to be put through to the ‘**RN superintendent of Diving**’

At other times, ask to be put through to the ‘**Duty Diving medical officer**’.

SUSPECTED DECOMPRESSION SICKNESS / EMBOLISM

Seek expert advice. Give 100% oxygen – as soon as possible – continuously.

Lie casualty down – raise legs.

FIRST AID

Maintain breathing / circulation

Remove from danger

Stem bleeding

Treat shock
